

Recreational Committee Meeting Minutes

DATE: Thursday, April 5, 2011

- 1) Minutes of Previous Meeting – distributed earlier via email
- 2) Season Summary – See summary outlining highlights for the season
- 3) Player Rating Sheets – Convenors at two levels are still chasing coaches to complete rating sheets. Six teams have not submitted them.
The VP will email a few of the minor midget coaches to come to a meeting and work on a process to consolidate the rating sheets for that level. Once the process is in place, other levels will be brought in to do the same.
- 4) Coaching applications for 2011-12 – Currently there are 33 applications in for next season. Monday, April 25th will be the night setup to interview new head coaches. Returning coaches will be contacted in May to confirm teams for next season. Convenors should pass on any concerns (if any) with respect to returning coaches.
- 5) Convenors 2011 – 12 – Henry will contact convenors to determine who is returning and what positions need to be filled for next year.
- 6) New Business
 - MacDonald's sponsorship – minor atom & atom (16 teams) will be provided with pro style sweaters, socks, coaching materials, etc for each of the teams. Team sponsors can also be put on the sweater provided it is not a food competitor of MacDonalds. There will be other benefits to the divisions as well.
 - Coach of the year – Criteria for selection was discussed: sportsmanship; dedication; player development; fair play and coach's evaluations. Nominations were reviewed. Coach's evaluation will be reviewed and a final selection will be made, with one winner from Minor Atom to Peewee and a second from Minor Bantam to Juvenile.
 - Cyd Suddard Award – Criteria for selection: sportsmanship, dedication, team leadership. The midget convenors will solicit names from the midget teams and make a selection for this award.
 - Awards will be presented at the AGM on Wednesday, April 20th
 - Request to not play during March Break – After some discussion it was decided that the schedule will remain the same. Removing playoff games from the weekends of the March Break would reduce the number of games during the season and would penalize the players not on vacation. The number of games played midweek will be kept to a minimum.

- Midget – two divisions of nine vs. three of six. – This request is being considered and will be reviewed over the summer to be finalized by late August prior to season start up.
- Older division only play two exhibition games then draft. – Discussion on how to set up the preseason in order that coaches can select their teams. Consideration is being given to the following: Minor Atom to Peewee playing an exhibition game, a skills session followed by a second exhibition game and then drafting teams. Teams from Minor Bantam to Juvenile will play only two exhibition games and then draft teams. More discussion will be needed and reviewed over the summer to be finalized by late August prior to season start up.
