**MINIMUM AGE TO ATTEND:** Participants must be a minimum of 14 years of age to attend the clinic. Participants aged below 16 will be identified with 'Associate Status' until they reach the age of 16. These young people serve as assistants to more experienced CHIP instructors in the program.

**REFUND POLICY:** Refunds for clinics will be given in full only when the Association is notified forty-eight hours in advance that the registrant will be unable to attend. No refund will be given to registrants who are turned away from clinics for being late.
