The Home Depot Coach of the Game

At every home game this season the Battalion will recognize a coach who has been nominated by his or her players and parents for their impact on their team and dedication as a minor hockey coach. The winning coach will be recognized during the first period of play and receive prizes from the Battalion and The Home Depot.

Battalion Fundraising Program

The Battalion Fundraising Program is proven to be a successful program for your team to raise money, enjoy a group outing, and benefit from some great rewards. We can confirm that Mandarin Restaurants has returned as a major sponsor and we'll advise additional rewards participants as soon as possible.

Included in every option are 20 complimentary tickets to a Battalion game for your team.

Option #1- Sell 50 Battalion tickets at \$13, keep \$5 for your team, thus making \$250 for your team. This option includes a group outing (sponsor yet to be finalized).

Option #2- Sell 100 Battalion tickets at \$13, keep \$5 for your team, thus making \$500 for your team. This option includes two group outings (Mandarin plus another sponsor yet to be finalized).

Option #3- Sell 200 Battalion tickets at \$13, keep \$5 for your team, thus making \$1,000 for your team. This option includes the two group outings from option 2, plus an hour of ice time before or after a Battalion home-game. The first 3 teams to have sold their 200 tickets between now and the end of November will have the option of turning their free hour of ice-time into a one-hour practice run by the Battalion coaching staff.

If teams want to have the hour of ice time, but don't think that they can sell 200 tickets, a great option is for two teams to work together to sell the 200 tickets, get the hour of ice time, and have a game between those teams during your free hour. Just another option for you to consider.

Please note that initial demand for tickets for the games on Sunday, Nov. 8 at 2:00 against Toronto Maple Leafs' 1st-round pick Nazem Kadri and the London Knights, and on Sunday, Nov. 15 against the reigning Memorial Cup champion Windsor Spitfires, we cannot accept requests for more than 100 tickets per team.
